We need you at Masses at St. John Vianney Parish, and also at Arnot's Taylor Health Center in Bath. Taylor Health Center is requesting Eucharistic Ministers to visit once a week. If you have the time and

can help, you will need to sign up as a volunteer. You will also need to fill out some paperwork, such as showing that you have had the MMR vaccination for Measles, Mumps and Rubella, as well as a TB test. You will also need to have had a COVID vaccination, or to get one. Then, a little orientation will be needed to make sure you are keeping yourself and the residents safe, using protocols such as hand sanitizing after each room visit. You will be given an ID as a volunteer, to go into the facility to minister without any problem. These procedures are required by New York State. If you are able to volunteer, or have any questions, please call the Parish Office, so that we can get ministers back for each week.
