We need you at Masses at St. John Vianney Parish and to help at Arnot Taylor Health Center. First, if you have the time and can help, you will need to sign

up as a volunteer. Once a week Arnot is requesting the Eucharistic Ministers to visit. However, you will need to fill out some paperwork, such as showing that you have had the MMR vaccinations for Mumps, Measles, and Rubella, as well as a TB test. You also need to have had a COVID vaccination, or to get one. Then a little orientation to make sure you are keeping yourself and the residents safe, using other protocols such as hand sanitization after each room visit. An ID as a volunteer will be given to you, to go into the facility to minister without any problem. These are procedures for New York State. If you are able to volunteer or have questions please call the Parish office so we can get ministers back each week.
