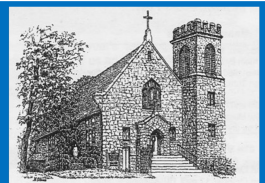

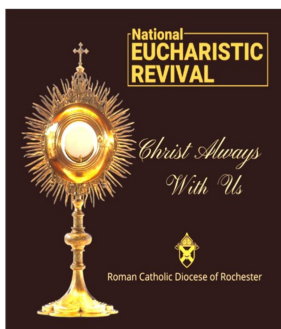

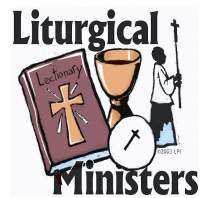

## Bulletin Announcement

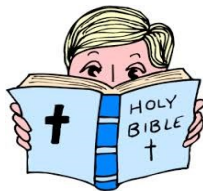
