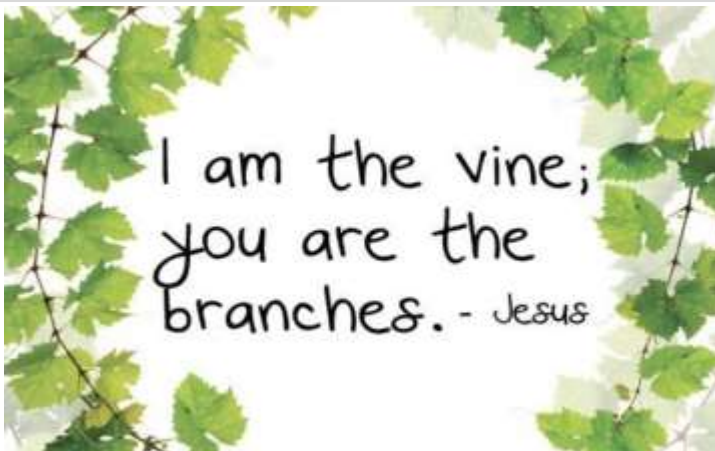

Furniture, tools, kitchen supplies or appliances,

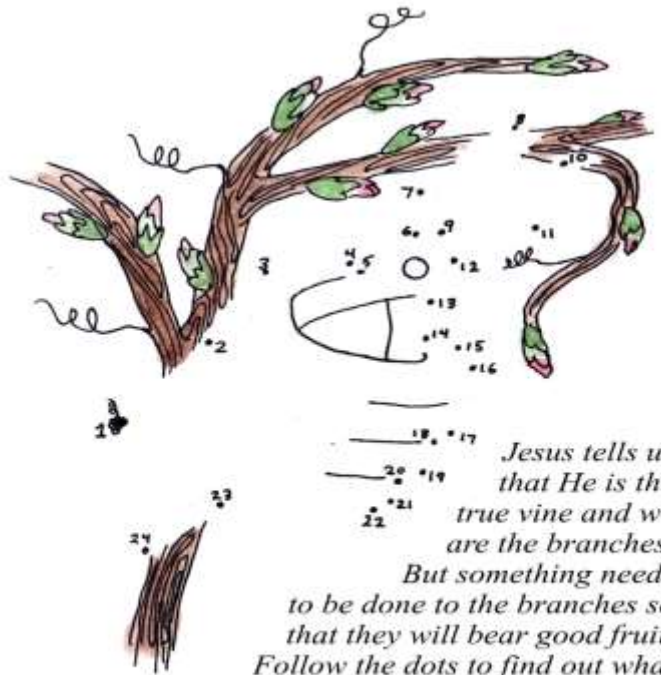
Bedding or linens, toys, games, puzzles or recreational items
