

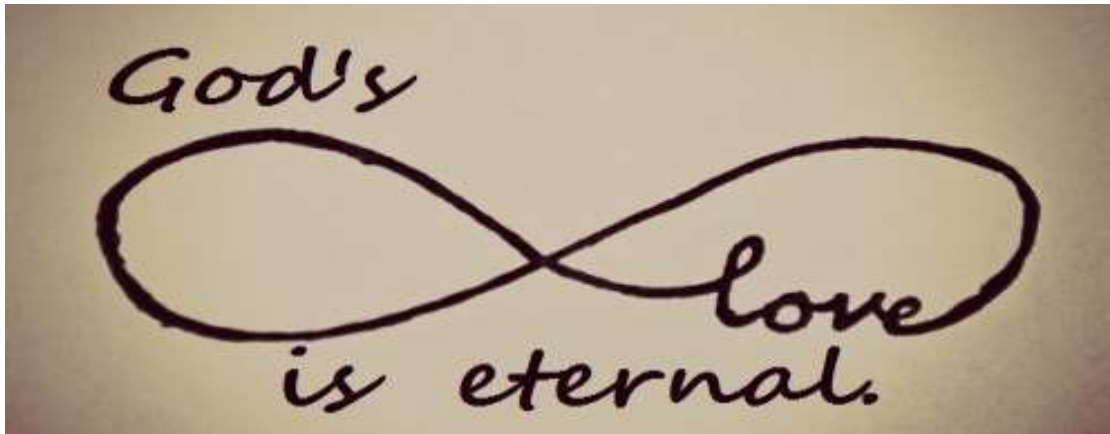

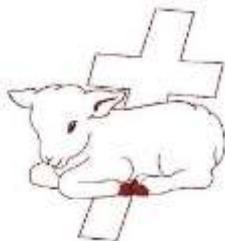


Apostles' Creed

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

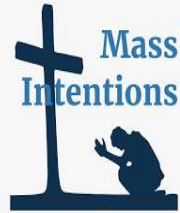
