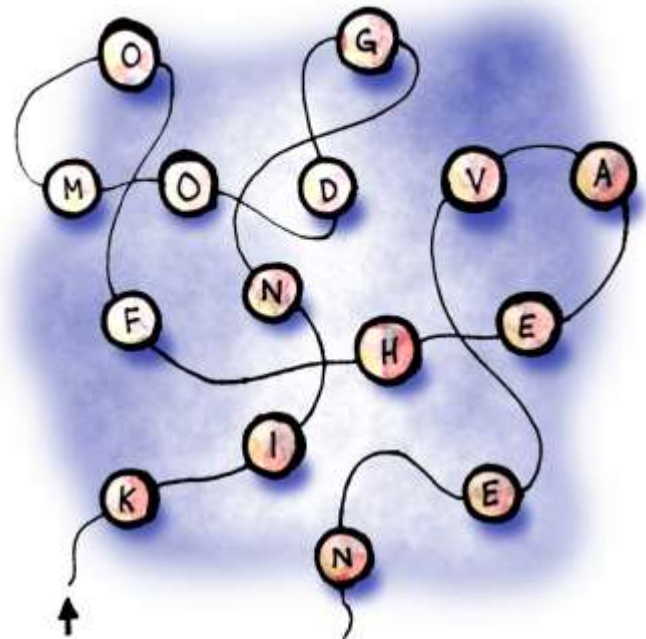
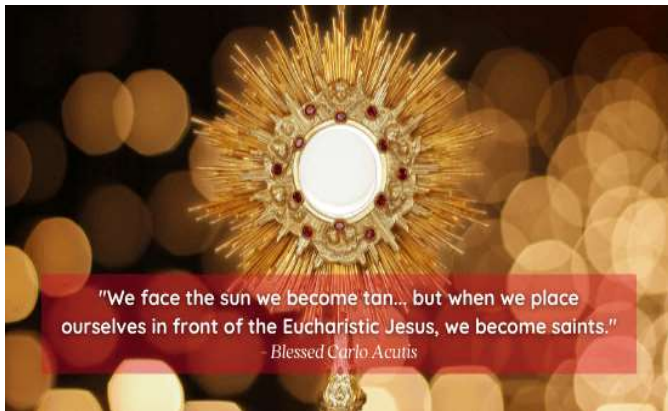
will be next Sunday August 13th after the 10 am Mass followed with a light brunch. Need not be present to win
