During Lent, Stations of the Cross will be at St. Mary's every Wednesday at 5:00 pm followed by Mass at 5:30 pm.



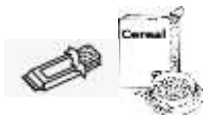

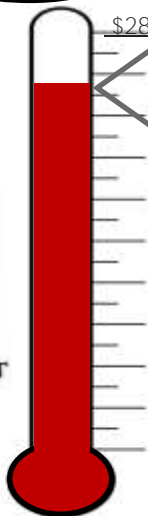
