Being a good steward and sharing the Good News can take many forms.

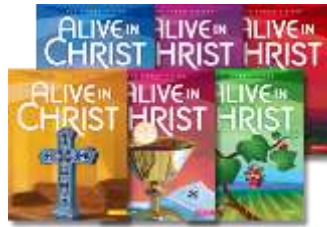

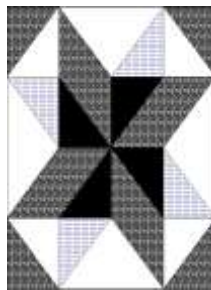
