Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, altar servers, choir, etc. Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.


The GriefShare program will once again be starting in February for people dealing with the loss of loved ones. Dates, times and session details TBD. Please watch upcoming bulletins for further details.


