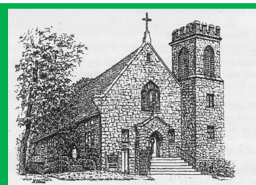

**July 31st** will be the last day to drop off any shoes you have for the youth. We will no longer be accepting them.

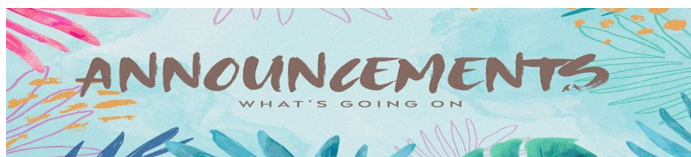
All SHOES (as well as slippers, and all sports shoes) accepted, but no roller skates, roller blades, or ice skates.
