The Fucharist vs. Communion??

Communion is the <u>verb</u> (being a part of Communion or being in Communion with the saints) while the Eucharist is the noun (the person of Jesus Christ). Communion refers to the Sacrament of Holy Communion, celebrated at every Mass



Our next anointing will be Saturday, July 15th after the 4:00 pm Mass and on Sunday, July 16th after both Masses.




