In the upcoming weeks you will see different quotes in the bulletin about the Eucharistic Revival. These quotes are to lead us to a deeper understanding and love of the Eucharist. On the Feast of Corpus Christi (June 12th), we entered into the "Parish Year" of the three-year National Eucharistic Revival.

### The Eucharist vs. Communion??

Communion is the verb (being a part of Communion or being in Communion with the saints) while the Eucharist is the noun (the person of Jesus Christ). Communion refers to the Sacrament of Holy Communion, celebrated at every Mass

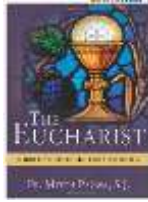


**Help Wanted!**
