It is a Catholic Charities outreach of the Rochester Diocese. Natasha Thompson is CEO of the Food Bank. We have lots of food insecurity and hunger in the Southern Tier due to challenges such as Covid-19, inflation, supply chain problems, and lack of employment businesses. Our Catholic Charities and Food Bank has served 1.3 million requests and 13.5 million pounds of food through partner agencies. I do it to remind ourselves of the support we should continue to contribute to such worthy causes. Although school is out soon for summer where kids can eat in lunch programs, it **doesn't mean an end to hunger. Please help feed America! If we don't support the food bank and Catholic Charities, there won't be such good news!**

I heard Rev. Barber on the radio say "poverty & hunger" are the 4th cause of death. He said not only are some arguing about budget deficits, we also seem to have a moral deficit in this country. To me, that means the rich are poor and lacking in compassion and empathy for others! **There's an idea to chew on!  All of this we ask in the name of Jesus, your beloved Son. Amen.

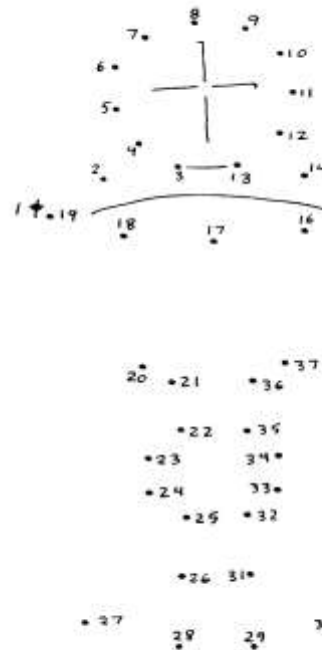
