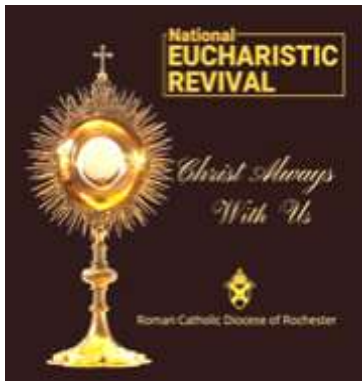


The Eucharistic Revival begins, across the United States of America, on Corpus Christi Sunday!
