Sunday, June 11th is the Feast of Corpus Christi. I'm planning & hope to commission Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at this important liturgical time. It is part of our parish's Revival of the Eucharist and new procedures from the Diocese and USCCB. It is a 3-year term. Therefore, I urge those who have said YES to have their form filled out with the information we need in order to get approval from the Diocese. Please return the form to the office by Monday, May 15th. I have set two dates for "Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion" training sessions, and you must attend in order to become or continue to serve as a Eucharistic Minister. The dates are as follows: Saturday, May 20th, from 10:30 am to 12:00 pm, or Thursday evening, May 25th, from 7:00 to 8:30 pm. A reminder that no one can be permitted to bring Holy Communion to their family or another individual unless they have attended this training and have been approved by the Diocese. Our Priest, Deacons & approved Eucharistic Ministers will bring communion to those who request it. After June 11th, I plan to have St. John Vianney in compliance with the rest of the Diocese and the USCCB.
