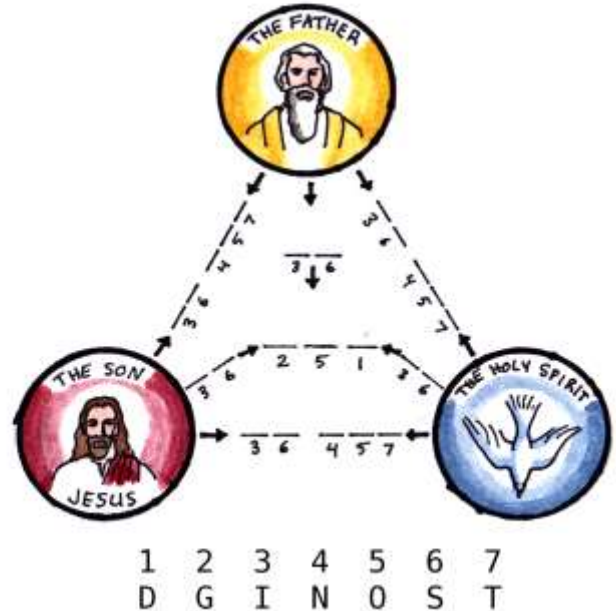


What is the Blessed Trinity?
