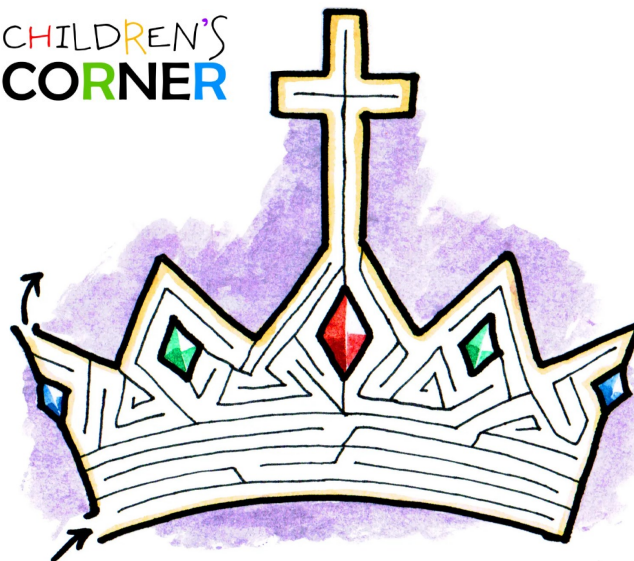
THANGSGIVING DINNER PRAYER
