

HOW DO YOU PRAY THE HOLY ROSA

The Holy Rosary is a prayer that commemorates twenty mysteries of the lives of Jesus and Virgin Mary.



Steps to pray:

1. Make the sign of the Cross and recite the Apostle's Creed 2. Say one Our Father

- 3. Say 1 Hail Harys and 1 Glory Be
- A. Neditate on the first mystery and say the Our Father
- 5. Say 10 Hall Marys and 1 Glory Be
- Exercise in each mattery 7. Recite the Hail Holy Queen
