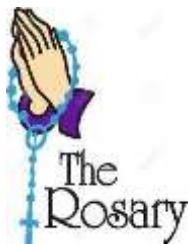

The Rosary



During the month of October, beginning 15 minutes before Mass, we will pray the rosary together prior to the start of all our Masses. Rosaries will be available in each church for those who need one. Our intentions for the month will be for the success of the Eucharistic Revival and reigniting the zeal of faith.

HOW DO YOU PRAY THE HOLY ROSARY?

The Holy Rosary is a prayer that commemorates twenty mysteries of the lives of Jesus and Virgin Mary.



Steps to pray:

1. Make the sign of the Cross and recite the Apostle's Creed
2. Say one Our Father
3. Say 3 Hail Marys and 1 Glory Be
4. Meditate on the first mystery and say the Our Father
5. Say 10 Hail Marys and 1 Glory Be
6. Repeat in each mystery
7. Recite the Hail Holy Queen

MYSTERIES:

- Joyful (Monday and Saturday)
- Luminous (Thursday)
- Sorrowful (Tuesday and Friday)
- Glorious (Wednesday and Sunday)

Pick up will be in early December.



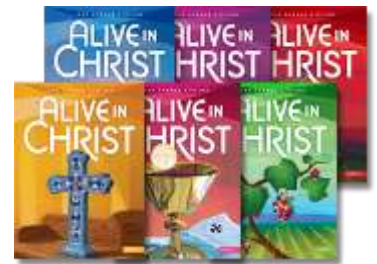

Volunteers are needed for the Clothing Shed, Eucharistic Ministers & Greeters/Ushers for both churches, & Sacristan for St. Mary's Church.

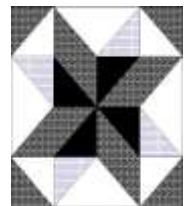


Many Hands Make **LIGHT** Work

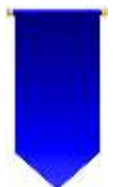
