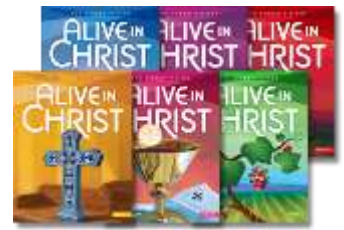
Pick up will be in early December.
