Weekly Church Announcements

From Deacon Dave

Hi everyone! Remember me? When I was preparing to have my aortic valve replaced this past June, I fully expected that I would be away from the parish for only a few weeks. Little did I know that following my aortic valve replacement, I would suffer a stroke that would severely impact my ability to walk due to balance issues. The icing on the cake was when I had to go back the following week in order for them to give me a pacemaker. (UGH) Following my stay at Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, I eventually was admitted into the inpatient rehabilitation program at the Guthrie facility in Towanda, Pa. I spent a week essentially learning how to walk without falling on my face. I was discharged from the Towanda facility on July 15th, able to walk on my own, as long as I had the use of a cane. I was given exercises to do at home and it was recommended that I begin outpatient rehabilitation as soon as I could. I started outpatient rehab at the Healthworks facility in Painted Post during the middle of August. I met weekly with my physical therapist who focused on helping me with my ongoing balance and dizziness issues. While my balance issues have improved, my PT has recommended that I see another PT, who has a separate practice, and who specializes in treating dizziness and balance disorders. I am scheduled to see the new PT on October 17th.

My journey to full recovery has been slow. I have good days where I feel fine. I also have bad days where I do not feel well at all. I will say that recently I am having far more good days than bad days. I feel very grateful for all the thoughts and prayers and "get well" cards that I have received from the parishioners of Saints Isidore and Maria Torribia Parish. Your prayers and get well wishes have been deeply appreciated by me. I am also very grateful for all the prayers and get well cards that I received from the parishioners at St. John Vianney Parish in Bath and Hammondsport as well as the parishioners at St. Mary's of the Lake in Watkins Glen. I feel very blessed to have so many wonderful people praying for my recovery.

The good news is that all of your prayers seem to be working. As I write this bulletin article, I plan to deacon and preach the 4:00 pm Mass at St. Joseph's Church in Campbell on Saturday, October 7th. I am not sure if I am ready to do a full weekend with all 4 Masses just yet but as soon as I am able, I will. In the meantime, I look forward to the day when I will be able to see all of you at church. Until then, please know that you are all in my thoughts and prayers.
