St. John Vianney Parish Census

Our St. John Vianney Parish, along with all other parishes in the Diocese, is conducting a parish-wide census. The goal is to ensure all households have updated contact information, specifically email addresses and phone numbers to enhance pastoral care, stewardship, and communication. You are urged to participate in this update.

There will be many opportunities to participate in the parish census:

Online: Emails will be sent inviting your household to submit your details digitally-this is the most efficient way to participate.

During Mass: This weekend, October 12th and 13th & the following weekend October 19th & 20th, we will provide in-pew, step-by-step instructions on how to complete the census form.

Bulletin: After the week following our in-pew census, we will be inserting paper copies of the census in the bulletin.

Why is our parish conducting a census? The purpose is to gather precise and current data on all registered parishioners to strengthen pastoral care, stewardship, and communication efforts.

Do I still need to complete the census if my information has not changed? Yes. Everyone is asked to participate in the census to ensure that our database is up-to-date and accurate.

How will my information be utilized or managed? All information will be handled with the utmost confidentiality. The data collected will be used solely for pastoral, stewardship, and communication purposes.

I have already completed the census form online, do I still need to fill out an in-pew census card? Yes. There is a place on the census card to indicate that you have already completed the form online.

How do I complete the census if I have not received an email? Contact the parish office to confirm we have your email address. Alternatively, you can complete the census by using the following QR Code:
