If you are feeling particularly depressed, hopeless, or sad remember that sharing with someone else helps. You do not have to fight this alone. Reaching out to talk with a close relative or friend, or a support organization may feel frightening initially. Allow yourself to be vulnerable **to take that first step. Even if you can't find the 'right words', things will start to become clearer and more hopeful.** If you are experiencing suicidal

thoughts, call or text 988 and get connected to crisis care immediately.

“Almighty God, receive our prayer on behalf of our souls that thirst and our flesh that fades.

Look upon us in the nights when there is no sleep and our beds are wet with tears.

To those carrying the burden of suicidal impulses, give relief, a respite from the turmoil.

To those who sit in darkness that it is to grieve a loved one who has died by suicide, give light, even a glimpse of hope.

Alert us to the indications that someone is in need of intervening help.

Open our eyes to the depth of their depression

Send us to one another with cups of cool water.

Send us ears more ready to hear than tongues ready to speak.

This we pray for your glory and our peace. Amen.”

National Eucharistic Revival

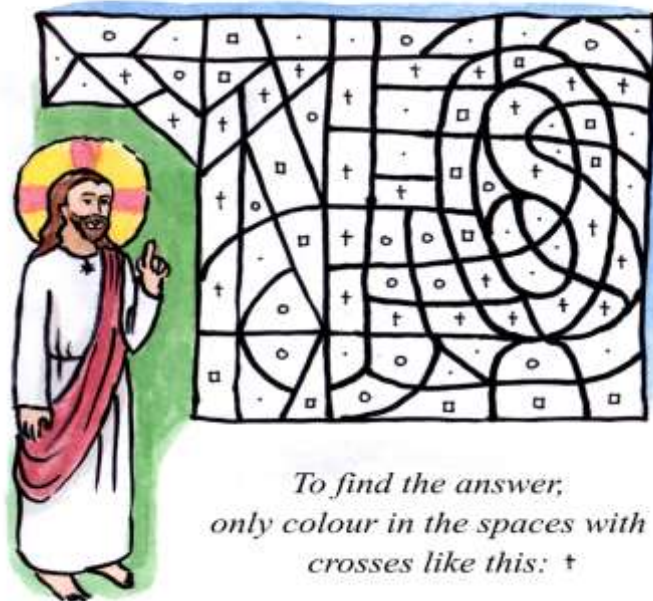
