Bishop Matano has announced recently that the policies, guidelines and permissions previously issued from the diocesan office between March 2020 and May 2021, for the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the administration of the Sacraments during the Coronavirus pandemic, are hereby rescinded with the exception of those noted below:

Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks in accordance with federal CDC guidance. **Consistent with the State's implementation of recent CDC**

guidance, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals.

Holy Communion is distributed only under one form, namely the Sacred Host.

The principal celebrant's chalice is not shared; concelebrating priests should have individual chalices for the reception of the Precious Blood, or they receive both Sacred Species by intinction.

The exchange of the sign of peace, which is always optional, either continues to be omitted or only encouraged without **shaking hands or holding hands in accord with the Church's** instruction.

Our churches, as the house of God, should continue to be kept clean, especially commonly touched surfaces. Cleaning in-between Masses is no longer needed.

Holy water fonts remain empty.

Baptisms continue to use only fresh water for each baptism and the fonts are cleaned afterwards.

It is recommended that some "social distancing" seating should still be offered, as needed.

Therefore, our Breaking Bread Missalettes have been restored to the pews, but out of abundance of caution, the presider and deacons will continue to wear a mask at the Altar and while distributing Holy Communion for the sake of the entire community.

This indicates another step forward. Thank you for your patience as we move closer toward full normalcy as more and **more people receive the vaccination. May God's grace guide us** and bring us to that day.
